London Breast Meeting is being held at the Royal College of Physicians (RCP), 11 St Andrew's Place, Regent's Park, London NW1 4LE. Getting to the RCP is simple. Within easy access to all London's major airports, superb connections from all mainline rail stations including Euston, King's Cross and St Pancras (Eurostar) Stations, a short walk from Regent's Park, Great Portland Street or Warren Street underground stations, and moments from numerous hotels (please see more detailed directions overleaf).

With its stunning park location, the RCP offers an impressive setting for the London Breast Meeting. Regent's Park is a huge, green expanse in the heart of the capital, within close proximity of London's main attractions and The City. Close to popular attractions including London Zoo (set in Regent's Park), Madame Tussauds, Marylebone High Street, The British Museum, Camden Town and London's best shopping streets such as Covent Garden, Oxford Circus, Regent's Street and Bond Street. Other main attractions such as Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey and The Houses of Parliament are a short ride away on public transport or taxi.

## How to get to the venue

### By road

- From the north: A4201 Albany Street from A41 North, the M1, A1, M40 and M25
- From the east: A501 Euston Road from A13 East, the M25, the M20 and the M2
- From the west: A501 Marylebone Road from A40 Westway, the M4 Heathrow and the M25
- From the south: A4201 Portland Place from Westminster and the A23, M25 and M23 Gatwick

### Car parking

- The RCP has free car parking for disabled visitors and limited parking for event organisers. It is situated outside the congestion charge zone.
- There are public car parks located on A4201 Portland Place, Devonshire Street,

Munster Square, Cardington Street within walking distance. Please refer to the map.

### By underground

- Regent's Park Station on the Bakerloo line (3 minutes' walk)
- Great Portland Street Station on the Circle, Metropolitan and City lines (5 minutes' walk)
- Warren Street Station on the Victoria and Northern lines (10 minutes' walk)
- Visit Transport for London's journey planner

### By train

- Euston Station (15 minutes' walk)
- King's Cross Station (5 minutes by taxi)
- St Pancras Station – Eurostar terminal (5 minutes by taxi)
- Marylebone Station (5 minutes by taxi)

### Cycle stands

### By air

- Heathrow: Express train from Heathrow Airport (15 minutes to Paddington Station, then 3 stops on the Underground to Great Portland Street Station)
- Gatwick: Express train from Gatwick Airport (30 minutes to Victoria Station, then 3 stops on the Underground to Warren Street Station)
- Stansted: Express train from Stansted Airport (45 minutes to Liverpool Street, then 5 stops on the Underground to Great Portland Street Station)
